US subsidiary Turner continues series of hospital contracts/Two new projects in California for EUR 119 million

HOCHTIEF is bolstering its leading position in the healthcare facilities segment in the US: In California, the Group's American subsidiary Turner Construction Company will extend two hospitals under contracts with a combined volume of approximately EUR 119 million (USD 162 million). The Group thus continues its course of growth in the healthcare market. In this segment, Turner was awarded contracts with a total volume of more than EUR 585 million (USD 800 million) so far this year, and in Germany, HOCHTIEF Facility Management only recently took on technical building management for seven clinics.

The two new contracts in the US comprise the extension of existing hospitals: At the West Mercy San Juan Medical Center in Carmichael, California, Turner will build an additional patient tower. The project, representing a volume of EUR 62 million (USD 85 million), is scheduled for completion in March 2010. On the premises of the healthcare center in Stockton, also in California, a new Women's and Children's Pavilion will be constructed. The contract is worth some EUR 57 million (USD 77 million). Project completion is scheduled for January 2010.
