HOCHTIEF Facility Management operating Central Bus Station in Munich

Facility manager advised project developers in advance and is now taking over technical operations

For the next two years HOCHTIEF Facility Management will be operating the Central Bus Station (ZOB) in Munich. This has just been agreed with HOCHTIEF Projektentwicklung, which developed the showcase property in the Bavarian state capital. HOCHTIEF Facility Management won the contract in an open bidding process. It was agreed that no details of the contract value would be disclosed.

The ZOB sets new standards: For the first time in Germany a bus station has been built based on the model of non-aviation areas in international airports, as a combined transportation, service and commercial center. In future, around 30,000 national and international tour buses will be handled every year at 29 terminals. A total of 25,000 square meters of space has been created. HOCHTIEF Facility Management already advised the project developer during the design phase of the project: Thus during the construction phase the incidental costs of later operation were analyzed - an important factor in negotiating lease agreements. With immediate effect the HOCHTIEF facility managers are ensuring smooth technical operations in the ZOB, taking care of security in the building, and looking after the infrastructure.
