HOCHTIEF Facility Management adds first electric car to motor fleet

**Use of environmentally-friendly cars underlines commitment to sustainability
- 120,000 tons of CO2 cut last year**

HOCHTIEF Facility Management has added its first electric car to its service vehicle fleet: With immediate effect a Micro-Vett 500 E made by RWE Effizienz will be part of the facility manager's mobile technical service fleet in the Ruhr. With this move, the HOCHTIEF subsidiary is one of the first companies in the industry to choose electric-powered mobility.

The new e-car is modeled on the Fiat 500. It is fitted with a modern lithium-ion battery and has a range of between 100 and 140 kilometers. For HOCHTIEF Facility Management, adding electric cars to its motor fleet is a further consistent step in its commitment to sustainability. Together with its sister subsidiary HOCHTIEF Energy Management, it assists companies in reducing their CO2 emissions. Last year, total carbon dioxide emissions were reduced by 120,000 tons with the help of modern energy management.
